**Act One:** 

Prologue:

Two families from Verona, Italy have a rivalry. The son and daughter of the families fell in love, only to commit suicide. It was their deaths that caused the end of the on-going rivalry. The death of the son and daughter was the only way the fighting was to end. Here is their story:

Verona Scenery and flashes

Scene One:

Two Capulet servants converse in the streets while trash-talking the Montagues. A fight breaks out between them. Benvolio (Montague) tries to stop the fight until Tybalt (Capulet) urges him on to fight as well. The Lords and Ladies Capulet and Montague join the dispute as the people of Verona attempt to stop it all. Prince Escalus comes to put an end to the mob and says the next member of the families to fight will be put to death. The Lord and Lady Montague then ask Benvolio what occurred and where their son, Romeo, is. Benvolio promises to find and console a love-sick Romeo.

Scene Two:

Lord Capulet debates a marriage between his daughter and Count Paris, a suitor. Capulet does not want Juliet married, because she is only 13 and asks that Paris waits a few years. Paris is invited to Lord Capulet's party and sends a servant to attend to the rest of the guest list. The servant cannot read and asks Romeo to read the list to him. Romeo and Benvolio then decide to attend in secret to get Romeo to compare Rosaline (the woman he is "in love with") to other women. Romeo only agrees to go because of Rosaline.

Scene Three:

Lady Capulet asks the Nurse to fetch Juliet. They talk of Juliet marrying Count Paris. Juliet hasn't even thought about getting married, but says she will look for him at the party and consider the marriage. Scene Four:

Romeo, Benvolio, and Mercutio are outside the Capulet house party in their masks. Romeo is being discontent and a bit of a pessimist. Mercutio makes several sexual references from all that Romeo says. Romeo finally explains a bad dream he had about this party. Mercutio jokes about the dreams being filled with mythical creatures, until he changes his rant into a more serious speech. Romeo essentially puts an end to his mindless rant. They go inside with Romeo mindful of a bad premonition.

Scene Five:

Inside, servants bustle about, and Lord Capulet greets everyone. Romeo sees Juliet and is immediately captured by her beauty. Tybalt recognizes Romeo's voice and brings up the subject to Lord Capulet. Capulet refuses to let Tybalt fight due to the Prince's threat from earlier. Frustrated, Tybalt leaves. Romeo then approaches Juliet. The two briefly speak in riddle and poetry, being so in love with each other. They kiss and kiss once more, until Nurse says Lady Capulet must speak with Juliet. Romeo learns from Nurse Juliet is a Capulet and leaves distressed. Juliet has Nurse find out Romeo's name. Juliet is also upset that she is in love with a Montague.

# Act Two:

## Prologue:

Romeo now loves Juliet, rather than Rosaline. Juliet loves him the same. Their families hate each other, but their love is strong.

#### Scene One:

Romeo hops the garden wall into the Capulet grounds. Mercutio and Benvolio look for him. They talk of love, what they believe it is, and what Romeo thinks of it. The two men give up the search for Romeo. Scene Two:

Romeo walks in the grounds and spots Juliet on a balcony. He listens to her confess her love for him. He is entranced by her, hanging on every word she says. He then startles her by speaking out. She is embarrassed for having him hear her profession of love. They confess their love for each other. Nurse begins to call out for Juliet impatiently. They plan to marry the next day at nine.

# Scene Three:

Friar Laurence speaks of medicines, poisons, and the nature of humans. Romeo then enters to speak with Friar of his and Juliet's plan of marriage. However, Friar inquires about Rosaline. Romeo sets him straight and speaks of how in love he and Juliet are. Friar agrees to marry them because he believes it will help settle the families' feud.

# Scene Four:

Mercutio and Benvolio talk of Tybalt wanting to duel with Romeo. Mercutio says he will fight when the time comes. Romeo comes to them less love-sick than the night before. Nurse comes (with her servant Peter), and Mercutio and Benvolio make fun of her. Romeo tells Nurse that Juliet is to go to Friar Laurence's cell to marry him that afternoon. The Nurse promises to leave a ladder for Romeo to get into Juliet's room that night.

# Scene Five:

Juliet waits for Nurse nervously. Nurse comes in, sends off Peter, and says to be exhausted. This makes Juliet more angry and anxious. Nurse finally tells Juliet to meet Romeo, and goes to fetch the ladder. Scene Six:

Romeo (with Friar Laurence) is ridiculously excited. Juliet arrives. She and Romeo go off to be married.

# **Act Three:**

# Scene One:

Mercutio and Benvolio walk outside, and Mercutio feels like a fight with the Capulets is bound to happen if their paths cross. Tybalt (and others of the house of Montague) enter and taunt Mercutio and Benvolio who respond in a similar manner. Romeo comes in, and Tybalt tries to provoke him to fight. Romeo won't fight him because Tybalt is now his cousin-in-law. Frustrated, Mercutio begins to fight Tybalt. Romeo tries to stop them, but Mercutio is stabbed by Tybalt under Romeo's arm. Tybalt and gang flee. Mercutio dies, but curses the Capulets and Montagues before he does. Tybalt comes back angry and fights Romeo. Romeo stabs Tybalt, who dies, and then Romeo runs away. Lords and Ladies Montague and Capulet meet the Prince while Benvolio tells of what happens. Prince banishes Romeo.

## Scene Two:

Juliet can't wait for Romeo to come see her. The Nurse tells Juliet of what all has transpired. Juliet thought Romeo was dead too, but was set straight. She thinks Romeo being banished is worse than anything else. Nurse will go to find Romeo and give him Juliet's ring as a token of love.

# Scene Three:

Friar Laurence tells Romeo he has been banished, not put to death. Romeo is devastated, and Nurse arrives. Romeo assumes Juliet hates him now and almost kills himself. Friar says Romeo should go see Juliet, but leave in the morning. He will go to Mantua and Nurse gives Romeo the ring as they depart. Scene Four:

Lord and Lady Capulet talk to Count Paris. They will not talk to Juliet because they think she is upset because of the death of Tybalt. Lord Capulet assumes Juliet will marry Paris because he says. Lord Capulet declares the wedding is to be held on Thursday.

#### Scene Five:

Romeo is about to leave, when Juliet tries to make excuses for him to stay. Nurse comes in saying Lady Capulet is about to come in and speak with Juliet. Romeo leaves through the window and says they will see each other again soon. Lady Capulet comes in to say Juliet is to marry Paris, but Juliet refuses. Lord Capulet comes in and says she will marry or be disowned. Juliet panics and asks Nurse what she ought to do. Nurse says she should just marry Paris, but Juliet goes to Friar Laurence for more help.

# **Act Four:**

# Scene One:

Friar talks to Paris about the wedding. When Juliet comes in, Paris gets excited. He kisses her before leaving. Friar then tells Juliet to drink a sleeping potion before the wedding, so she seems dead. She will wake up in the tomb with Romeo waiting for her. Friar will notify Romeo. The two will go to Mantua. Scene Two:

Juliet goes home and apologizes to her parents, who are getting ready for her wedding. She "agrees" to marry Paris. Lord Capulet is thrilled and moves the wedding to tomorrow. Lord Capulet goes to tell Paris. Scene Three:

Juliet asks Nurse and Lady Capulet to be alone. Quite nervous, she wonders if the potion will kill her. She thinks a ghost of Tybalt seeks out Romeo. She drinks it for Romeo, but keeps a dagger just in case. Scene Four:

Everyone is preparing for the wedding. Nurse goes to wake up Juliet. Paris is coming with musicians. Scene Five:

Nurse sees Juliet is dead and is frantically trying to fine Lord and Lady Capulet. All are upset, and Friar says they all ought to prepare for her funeral. When they leave, Peter tells the musicians to play something cheerful. The musicians wait for people to show up, so they can eat.

# **Act Five:**

# Scene One:

Romeo had a dream that Juliet found him dead, but kissed him alive. Romeo's servant, Balthasar, comes to tell him Juliet is dead. Romeo writes his father a letter and tells Balthasar to return to Verona, and Romeo will return tonight. Balthasar has no letter from Friar Laurence for Romeo. Romeo goes and bribes an apothecary to sell him poison. He plans to kill himself by Juliet in her tomb.

## Scene Two:

Friar Laurence talks to Friar John, with whom he sent the letter to Romeo. Friar Laurence asks how Romeo reacted, but Friar John didn't get it to Romeo, because there was an outbreak of the plague. Friar Laurence worries no one will be there when Juliet wakes up and goes to her. He asks for a crowbar to rescue her and sends another letter to Romeo.

#### Scene Three:

Paris and his servant are at Juliet's tomb where Paris is laying flowers. Romeo and Balthasar come with a crowbar. Balthasar leaves and is instructed to give Lord Montague the letter written that morning. Paris sees Romeo and thinks he's trying to destroy the tomb. Romeo asks Paris to leave, but they instead fight. Paris's servant goes to get the watchman. Romeo kills Paris who asked to be put by Juliet in her tomb. Romeo goes in and sees Juliet beautifully lying there. He wants to be with her forever, so kisses her. He then drinks the poison, only to kiss her once more and die. Friar Laurence comes to find Balthasar who says Romeo is in the tomb and had a dream Romeo killed someone. Juliet wakes up when Friar comes in. Friar wants her to leave with him because the watchman is coming and says Romeo and Paris are dead. Friar leaves without her, scared. She kisses Romeo trying to get the poison off his lips, but it does not work. She takes Romeo's dagger and is about to kill herself. A watchman finds blood by the tomb. Capulets and Prince come to find Romeo, Juliet, and Paris dead in the tomb. Lord Montague comes saying Lady Montague is dead because of grief caused by the exile of her son. The Prince asks Friar Laurence to tell of their marriage, which he does. The Prince claims it to be an explanation for all that has transpired. The families' feud caused the deaths of their children and other family members. Capulet and Montague agree to put it behind them. Lord Montague will make a golden statue for Juliet, and the Capulets will make a golden statue for Romeo.

Adam takes a swing at Sam. Enter Ben (MHS), Marcus (MHS), and Ty (VHS).


Ben: Guys, cut it out! Somebody saw Principal Eden!

Act 1, Scene 4


Ryan, Ben, and Mercutio wait outside Verona High School homecoming dance.

Josie: Josie Capulet. And yours?


Ryan: Ryan Montague. (Kisses her) I told you.

Josie: k. I had fun 2nite


Ryan: me 2.

**Ryan:** Ben, watch Marcus! Call for help! (Runs after Ty.)


Ty: What do you want Mantua? Are you here to fight this time?


Nicole: I wish I could tell you it wasn't true, but Josie went to show Ryan her acceptance letter.


Mr. Montague: It's our faults. It wasn't fair of us all to put so much pressure on them. It wasn't fair.


Mr. Capulet: It's true, but perhaps it's better this way.




